

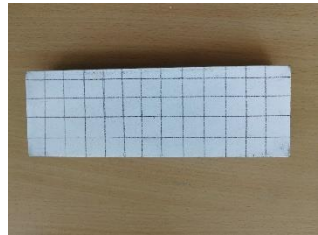

Flattening Stone – 150# Quick Start Guide

1. Please ensure the following items are in the box:
 - a. Flattening Stone
 - b. Quick Start Guide (*you are reading it now*)
 - c. Purchase Registration Card
2. On the Whetstone surface you wish to flatten, sketch horizontal and vertical approx. 1 cm apart, as shown in the image below.



3. Soak the both Whetstone and the Flattening Stone in clean water, completely submerged, for 15 minutes. See image below.





4. Remove the stone and place the Whetstone on a sturdy surface with the side to be flattened facing up.
5. Place the flattening stone with the grooved side facing down against the Whetstone surface to be flattened. See image below.



6. Apply light pressure and using a forward and backward motion, move the Flattening Stone along the surface of the Whetstone.
7. **Important** - Please keep the surface of Whetstone wet by spraying or splashing water onto it.
8. Keep the forward and backward motion until all the grid line pencil marks are removed as a result of this process. See image below which shows partial removal of pencil marks.



9. **Surface is flat when all pencil marks are removed.**
